

Engaging Families

Helping families in Cardinia experiencing family violence and alcohol and other drug harms or mental health challenges. Engaging Families is a **free** program that works with families in Cardinia Shire with children under 12 to:

- Increase safety from family violence
- Manage drug and alcohol related concerns and mental health
- Identify their unique strengths, needs, goals and the supports available in the community to help work towards them.





What happens in the program?

First we will get to know you and your goals during intake. We will work together to come up with a tailored plan that suits you.

This may include:

- Counselling
- Care and recovery (making a plan that brings together the services who can help in the areas you want to change)
- Case management (working with you on alcohol, drugs, family violence and mental health)
- Safety planning, family therapy and group work for family violence
- Parenting support.
